

FAQs about Theatre Jacksonville Summer Camps

What are the dates for camp?

Session A is from June 1, 2020- June 26, 2020

Session B is from July 6, 2020-July 31, 2020

Camp is Mondays through Fridays from 9:00am-2:00pm

Where is camp located?

The first three weeks are at the Trotter Activities Center, 1936 Hendricks Ave., 32207

The final week of camp is held at Theatre Jacksonville, 2032 San Marco Blvd.

What are the camp hours?

Camp begins at 9:00am and ends at 2:00pm, Monday through Fridays.

Is there early drop off?

Yes. The earliest a camper can be dropped off is 8:00am. The facility does not permit any camper to enter earlier than that.

Is there an extended day?

Yes. For \$10 a day. Extended day is from 2:00pm-5:30pm. 5:30pm is the facility cut off time and we are not permitted to stay any longer than that. If your child is not picked up by 5:30pm an additional \$10 fee will be added to your balance.

Do you provide lunch or snack?

No. We do have a snack and a lunch time, but campers are expected to bring a lunch every day. Microwave use is not permitted. Snacks should also be provided but we do offer a "Snack Shack" that provides chips, crackers, cookies, etc. for \$1 a snack.

When are the shows?

Camp A- June 24th at 6:00pm and June 25th at 1:00pm and 6:00pm.

Camp B- July 29th at 6:00pm and July 30th at 1:00pm and 6:00pm.

Do campers get complimentary tickets to the show?

Yes. Each camper is provided 2 complimentary tickets only. These complimentary tickets must be reserved when ticket purchases open, the the third week of camp. (please understand it is only 2 tickets per camper, not 2 tickets per show)

What do I do if a camper is sick?

Keep them home! Even if you are remotely concerned about your camper, with over 90 campers a session, it is safer to keep them home to prevent the spread of germs.

Do you pro-rate for missed days?

No. Theatre Jacksonville's Summer Camp is not a drop in camp. From the first day, campers are being prepared to put on a full 1-hour production with singing, dancing and acting and no day is wasted. If you miss a day, you will be caught up when you return.

Are phones/tablets/and other electronics permitted at camp?

Yes...HOWEVER, bring them at your own risk. Electronics can be used during the down time campers have at snack, lunch and extended day, but Theatre Jacksonville and the staff of camp are not responsible for any damage or lost/stolen property.
